

**LEWIS & CLARK LAW SCHOOL
DUBOFF JONES SCHOLARSHIP**

Amount: \$9000 to be granted to one or more students at the committee's discretion

Eligibility: Upper division students who will be attending in the 2008-09 academic year.

Criteria

A DuBoff-Jones application will want to address the following:

Passion for the Law. In the spirit of Ms. DuBoff Jones, the Committee will give preference to students who demonstrate a passion for the practice of law.

Financial Need. Financial need is an important criterion, and the committee will review a student's financial circumstances (debt, other financial support). Special consideration will be given to those students who are working as a means to minimize their school debt.

Scholarly Achievement. The committee will accept applications from students who, through their law school course work, have demonstrated high achievement. The minimum grade point average to apply for the scholarship is 3.0.

Additional Accomplishments. The committee will also look favorably on any expression of a student's interest in all facets of the law. This may be shown by the range of a student's extracurricular activities, either in school or outside of school, and the breadth of coursework taken.

Thus, the ideal DuBoff Jones scholarship recipient will have not only a strong academic record, but will also have demonstrated a commitment to his/her school, his/her profession and his/her community.
